available.



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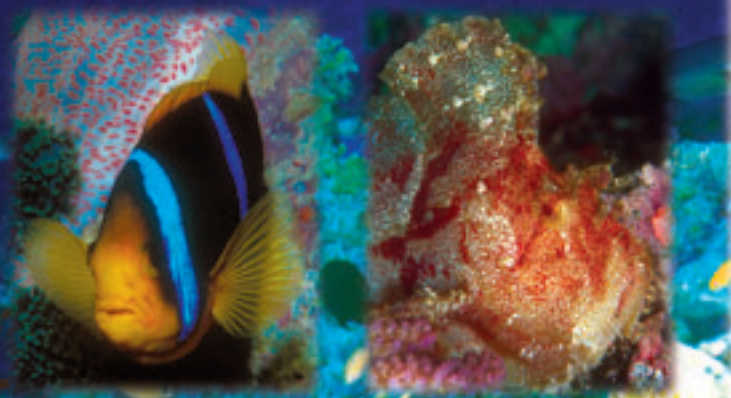

Our Dive Sites include:

Wakaya Passage:

A 1000m dropoff that is known for its hammerhead sharks, barracuda, and manta rays. The passage leads into a shallow lagoon.

The Goldfish Block:

An amazing shallow dive with fish life galore. Blue ribbon eels, garden eels, anemonefish, anthias; fish of all colours live here.



Levuka Wharf:

This wharf is home to some weird and wonderful creatures, including ghost pipefish, frogfish, lionfish, and more. If you like the strange and unusual, this is a dive for you!

The Cathedrals:

Blue corals line the walls here, and swimthroughs and caves are the name of the game. Schools of barracuda cruise the openings, and rays of sunlight penetrate the maze of tunnels.



Strange and Unusual!
The waters around Ovalau are becoming known for the strange and unusual creatures that can be found here. The waters here have produced encounters with some of the strangest 'critters' you are ever likely to encounter!

A highlight of any trip!

Pilot whales, spinner dolphin and humpback whales are often encountered in the deep water between Ovalau and Wakaya.



Hammers and Mantas!

Wakaya Passage is one of the few places where divers can regularly encounter scalloped hammerheads and manta rays as they cruise the walls of this magnificent reef system.



Levuka Passage:

Two minutes from the wharf, this wall is known for its reef sharks, morays, whip corals, and pelagics.

Waitovo Passage:

With a beautiful array of hard corals, this is the place for commensal creatures, beautiful fish, and losing yourself in the wonder of a coral reef.

The Pipeline:

For experienced divers only, this deep dive brings you into the realm of some of our larger species. Giant grouper, eagle rays, schools of batfish, and several species of sharks live down here.

Motoriki Passage:

is known for its soft corals, and teeming fish life.
